Sunnybank State School will receive**

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students meeting NAPLAN national minimum standard in Year 3 reading from 90.7% to 94% and Year 5 reading from 72.2% to 94% by 2015.
- Increase the number of students in the NAPLAN upper two bands in Year 3 reading from 30.2% to 36% and Year 5 reading from 30.6% to 36% by 2015.

Our strategy will be to

- Use data to inform the teaching of reading, writing and numeracy and the targeting of resources.
- Provide feedback to students and teachers to reinforce positive behaviours.
- Develop a consistent approach to reading, writing and numeracy instruction across the whole school.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Engaging a Literacy Coach one day a week to develop and support a whole school approach to the development of student literacy. | \$ 25,000 |
| • Engaging a Head of Numeracy one day a week to develop and support a whole school approach to the development of student numeracy. | \$ 25,000 |
| • Initiating a Language Acquisition Program (LAP) class with a full time teacher to provide intensive, targeted support for EALD students newly arrived from overseas. | \$ 80,000 |
| • Creating a Deputy Principal position to assist with the instructional leadership of staff teams and the implementation of the school improvement agenda. | \$ 14,000 |
| • Providing teacher release time each term for teacher teams to develop consistency in curriculum planning, implementation and assessment. | \$ 10,000 |
| • Provide additional teacher aide time to provide learning support to students identified through data monitoring. | \$ 25,640 |
